Hi,

I would like to state my objection to the proposed development at Dairy Farm Bungalow and Dairy Fields. I believe the plan for development of brownfield sites within the village is sound, however development of greenfield sites such of this, will create significant damage to the village, its natural surroundings and infrastructure. Key concerns include:

- the additional stress on the village school. We have 2 children at AKPS and it's already full to bursting; my daughters class has the stipulated maximum of 32 pupils, so it would just not be possible to accommodate a further influx
- Site access on Gosditch would cause huge disruption, both to the inhabitants and the school. There has already been several near misses due to school traffic in Gosditch and I have real concerns for safety of those walking to school
- Ashton Keynes is a rural community, this is an important open space used frequently by those in the village and also those walking the Thames path
- the urban sprawl in this area is of real concern, the roads and overall infrastructure required to support, would mean even more development which would be hugely damaging to the village community
